

Oceanside Summer Tournament 9-11U Baseball Rules

- 1- Universal batting order. 3 outfielders
- 2- Team will receive 1 warning for leaving base early. Runner will be sent back according to regular Little League Rules. After 1 team warning, a runner from the warned team, who leaves base early will be called out.
- 3- Catcher does not have to hold 3rd strike.
- 4- A pitched ball that hits ground prior to hitting batter is hit batsman.
- 5- Pitching register must be kept on hand. (**See Tournament Pitching Rules**)
- 6- The distance from pitching rubber to back of home plate will be 46 feet.
- 7- All players must play 3 innings in field per game (barring injury.)
- 8- Late arriving players may be added to bottom of lineup, and players who leave early will skip spot with no out recorded.
- 9- Tagging up is permitted.
- 10- Infield fly rule is in effect
- 11- Fielder must yield base path and bases unless making a play.
- 12- Free substitution on field except pitcher.
- 13- Speed up rule will be used with two outs and catcher or new next inning pitcher on base. Last batted out will run.
- 14- Forfeit time is 15 minutes after start time. 8 players constitute a team. No out for ninth spot.
- 15- 10 run rule after 4 innings, Equal at-bats.
- 16- Each team will have 1 manager and 2 coaches. Only manager may discuss calls/rulings with umpire. Abuse of umpires will not be tolerated.
- 17- Managers must keep players, coaches, and parents from behind backstop. Teams are responsible for the behavior of their fans.
- 18- Extra innings are permitted as long as you are under your time limit. Ties are permitted. Playoff rounds games must play to a winner. If daylight expires and score is tied, teams must return the following day to complete game (as if it was the same day.)
- 19- 4 innings constitute an official game. (3 1/2 if home team is ahead) Games shortened by weather that are not official or are tied, will be resumed from the spot it was stopped, on the following day (as if it was the same day.)
- 20- All games are 2 hour time limit.(no new inning after 1 hour and 45 minutes)
- 21- All Little League rules apply (unless covered by these rules.)
- 22- Rosters (max 15 players) must be submitted prior to first game.

Pitching Rules

8U

Pitchers can pitch only 2 innings per game and 4 in a week

9U, 10U

75 pitches per game max. (Pitcher may finish the batter if reaching 75 pitches during an at-bat.)

11U

85 pitches per game max. (Pitcher may finish the batter if reaching 85 pitches during an at-bat.)

9U, 10U, 11U

Pitchers cannot pitch in consecutive games.*

*Exception: 20 pitches or less can pitch in consecutive games.

Over 45 pitches require 2 days of rest.

Over 20 pitches require 1 day of rest.

Up to 20 pitches requires NO days of rest.
